Applicant	
Copy of the passport including the photo page of passport and any pages with amendments, endorsements, visas and entry/exit stamps for all applicants included in the application.	
One passport sized photos of each applicant	
Copy of birth certificates for each applicant (with certified English translation)	
Evidence of change of name (if applicable) (with certified English translation)	
Certified copies of the adoption papers, including evidence that the authority in the child's home country permits the child to migrate to Australia	
If the child has been adopted by expatriate adoptive parents without the support of an Australian state or territory central adoption authority: a written statement outlining the length of time and reasons for the adoptive parent's residence overseas.	
If the child has been allocated for adoption: a letter from the Australian state or territory central adoption authority supporting the adoption.	
Applicants 18 years and over	
Penal (police) clearances for each country in which the applicant has spent a cumulative total of 12 months or more in the last 10 years since turning 16 years of age.

Sponsor	
Evidence that the sponsor is an Australian citizen, permanent resident, or eligible New Zealand citizen (eg copy of passport)	
Copy of birth certificate (with certified English translation)	
A recent passport-sized photograph of the sponsor	
National ID card (RG) and CPF card (for sponsors who hold a Brazilian citizenship)	

 If the applicant is under 18 years of age: An Australian National Police Check for the sponsor, if the sponsor has spent a total of 12 months or more in Australia since turning 16 years of age. Penal (police) clearance from each country in which the sponsor has spent a cumulative total of 12 months or more in the last 10 years since turning 16 years of age.

If the applicant is under 18 years of age, and the sponsor has a spouse or de facto partner, that partner must provide the following:	
 An Australian National Police Check for the sponsor's partner, if the sponsor's partner has spent a total of 12 months or more in Australia since turning 16 years of age. 	
 Penal (police) clearance from each country in which the sponsor's partner has spent a cumulative total of 12 months or more in the last 10 years since turning 16 years of age.
